## THE SMITHFIELD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULAR BUSINESS MEETING JULY 28, 2020

  - b. Award the Bid for the Waterfront Park Fishing Dock Project. Julia Heilakka describes the current finances related to the project. The Board discusses approving the bid subject to DCNR approval so the contractor can get their bonds submitted.

Robert Lovenheim motions to accept the base bid from Pioneer Construction Co., Inc. with Alternate B subject to DCNR approval of the bid as a match for the DCNR grant, Jacob Pride seconds. Vote: all in favor; motion carries.

The Board confirms that Boucher & James should tell the contractor to move forward with bonding.
