THE SMITHFIELD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REORGANIZATION MEETING JANUARY 3, 2023

A Reorganization Meeting of the Smithfield Township Board of Supervisors was held on January 3, 2023, at the Smithfield Township Municipal Center at 1155 Red Fox Rd, East Stroudsburg, PA 18301, and via Zoom.

Present are Supervisors Jacob Pride, Robert Lovenheim, and Brian Barrett (via Zoom), and Jon Tresslar of LVL Engineers. Township Manager Julia Heilakka and Solicitor Ronold Karasek are excused.

- 1. Chair Jacob Pride calls the meeting to order at 6:00PM. A quorum is present.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance is recited.

Brian Barrett discusses making a motion to reappoint Doug Schryver and David Strunk to the Planning Commission. Jacob Pride discusses the need to hear from the third applicant before making a decision. Jacob Pride asks for a motion to table items 8.a. and 8.b. while approving item 8.c. Robert Lovenheim motions to table items 8.a. and 8.b. and approve item 8.c., Jacob Pride seconds. Vote: all in favor; motion carries.
