Spring Stormwater Management & Water Quality Tips

- 1) Plant native plants. Planting native trees, shrubs, and groundcover provides biodiversity. Native plants require less maintenance and water to survive.
- 2) <u>Mulch your grass clippings</u>. Leave grass clippings to decompose on your lawn. They are a good source of nitrogen fertilizer.
- 3) <u>Use chemicals sparingly</u>. Use fertilizer sparingly to ensure chemicals do not runoff during a rain event and enter a local stream.
- 4) Pick up pet waste. Pet waste contains unhealthy bacteria which can contaminate local streams. Pick up, bag, and dispose of pet waste property.
